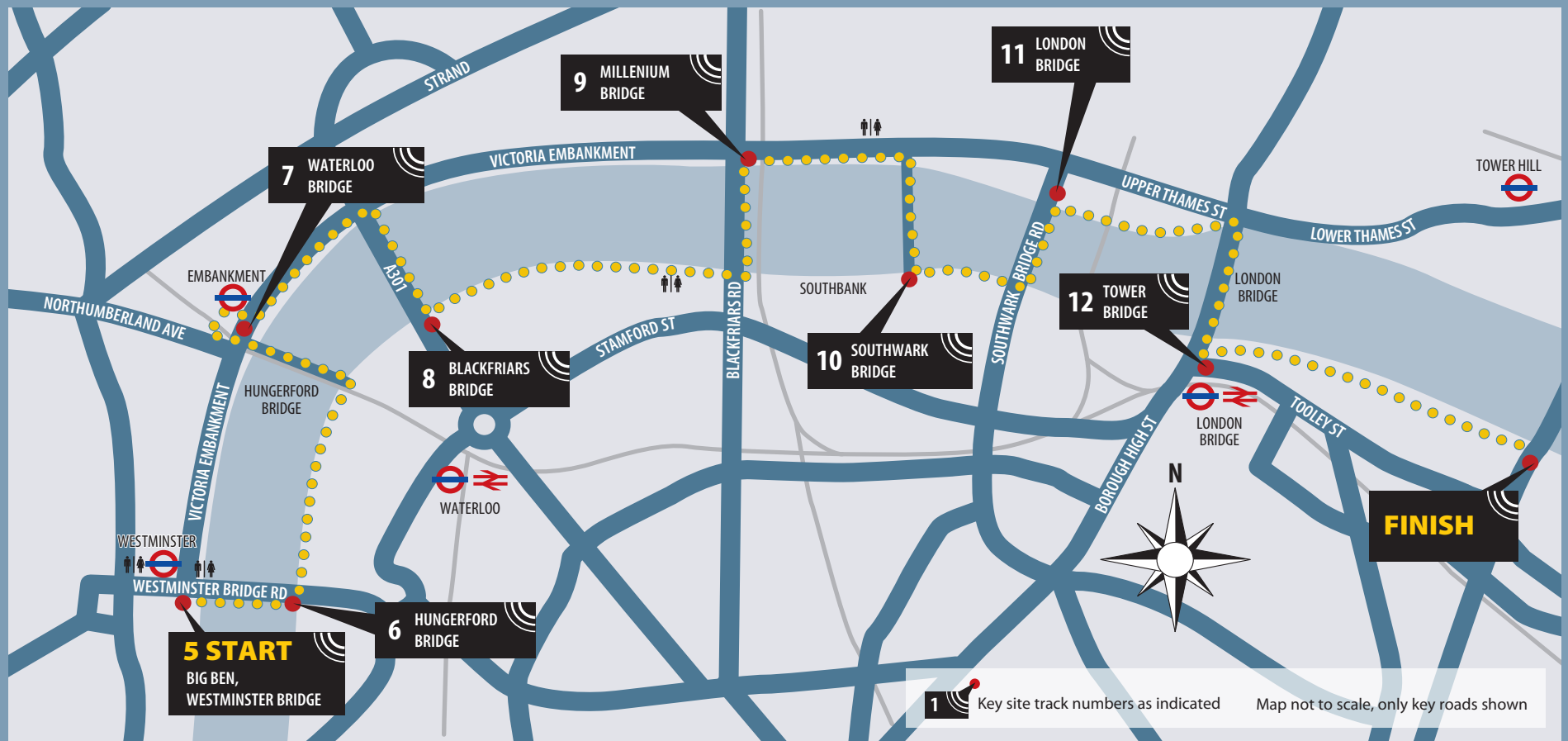


# LONDON'S BRIDGES CROSSING THE ROYAL RIVER



## STARTING POINT

Westminster Tube station. Exit 3 at the foot of Big Ben. Westminster Tube station is on the Jubilee, Circle and District Lines of The Underground.

## OPTIMAL DAYS & TIMES

Any day during daylight hours.

## DURATION

About 90 minutes, if you don't stop! But there are many great attractions on the walk including the Tate Modern so you may need to factor these into your plans. There are also many places to pause for a coffee, a bite to eat or an ice cream. Our web site provides a regularly updated list of our favourite spots to stop and relax during your walk.
